

Biotin-labeled Anti-Phosphoserine RABBIT POLYCLONAL

Format: PBS with 50% glycerol

Immunogen: phosphoserine-KLH conjugates

Specificity & Preparation: Pan-specific for phosphoserine, does not cross-react with phosphotyrosine, but slightly reacts with phosphothreonine. Affinity-purified with phosphoserine conjugated to agarose. Conjugated to d-biotin via acylation of the primary amine with active ester of biotin (NHS-activated d-biotin). The concentration is $250 \,\mu\text{g/ml}$.

Usage: Reported to be effective for ELISA (1:1000) and immunoblotting (western blot, 1:1000).

Storage: Store the antibody at -20°C. Stable for up to twelve months. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Gently spin down material 5-10 seconds in a microfuge before use.
